**IMPENDING TERMINATION OF THE IMPOSITION OF ANTI-DUMPING DUTIES ON IMPORTS OF POLYETHYLENE TEREPHTHALATE (PET) ORIGINATING OR EXPORTED FROM THAILAND**

We received a notice from Ministry of International Trade and Industry (MITI) Malaysia informing that the anti-dumping (AD) duties imposed on imports of polyethylene terephthalate (PET) originating from Thailand is due for expiry on **20 April 2016**. MITI invites interested parties to present their views on the impending termination of the imposition of the AD duties.

The subject merchandise is classified under the Harmonised System Code (HS Code) number 3907.60.000 and ASEAN Harmonised Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 3907.60.9000. The PET AD duties on PET importing from Thailand is subjected to AD duties **from 21 April 2011 to 20 April 2016**. The rates of the AD duties are between 5.33% to 49.25%.

Interested parties likely to be affected by the termination of the imposition of the AD duties are invited to present their views in writing. The views shall, in particular, address the following issues:

- (i) whether the continued imposition of the AD duties is necessary to offset the dumping of PET; and
- (ii) whether the injury would be likely continue or recur if the duties were removed.

Interested parties must present their views in writing and submit the required information not later than **20 January 2016**. The submission of the views shall be addressed to:
