Dear Members,


*The MPMA Secretariat was called for meetings on 21 June 2016 with DBKL and on 28 June 2016 with the Ministry of Federal Territories on the Implementation of Usage of Biodegradable Products (primarily on food packaging) in the Federal Territories. The Ministry had launched the initiative on 3 June 2016 and it will be implemented in four phases as explained in the **attached brochure**. The Ministry is currently preparing for Phase 2 of the initiative involving food trucks, pasar malams and restaurants in the Federal Territories.*

For your info, the Ministry is very firm in implementing this and thus invited MPMA members to be a part of the initiative in supplying biodegradable food packaging products. For manufacturers to be qualified as suppliers to these biodegradable food packaging products in the Federal Territories, the products have to be registered with the MyHIJAU Mark under the Malaysian Green Technology Corporation. Kindly visit the MyHIJAU website at <https://www.myhijau.my/> to understand more on the certification and you may also take a self-check test at <https://dir.myhijau.my/register> to pre-evaluate your products on whether they fulfill the requirements for the MyHIJAU Mark registration.

*Attached also is the **Guidelines for the Registration of MyHIJAU Mark Product** for your reference. Kindly note that the application fee is RM500 in which more than one product can be registered under the same certificate with a maximum validity period of three (3) years from the date certified.*
